

Special Road District #1  
Meeting Minutes  
November 24, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 6:03p.m. with Scott Asla, Bill Inman, Rodney Dieckhoff and 2 guests present. The meeting was opened with the approval of the minutes from the previous meeting, Bill made a motion to approve the minutes, Scott 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion all were in favor and the minutes from the previous meeting were approved. Bill presented the treasurers report and found nothing out of the ordinary. Scott made a motion to approve the treasurers report as presented with a correction to the placement of the snow chain purchase which should have been billed to the John Deere 872gp. Bill 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion all were in favor and the treasurers report was approved. Rodney gave the road report and stated that the roads were all in good shape even with the early wet snow. The new grader ran great with the exception of a couple of minor hi-cups which have since been resolved.

There were a couple of public comments both regarding snow removal, a guest wanted it noted that he felt the road district did an amazing job with the snow removal and he also wanted to ask if there will ever be a chance we will take over plowing Spring river rd. outside of our boundary. There was also a question about next years dust abatement plan and it was stated that as when we have a better idea on the plan it will be posted on the website. It was asked of the audience if there were any nominations for the up coming elections at next months meeting and there were none. Scott gave a brief update from last week's county meeting, those included further study in our district to install speed signs, there may be a possibility that the county may take over maintenance/ responsibility of the culvert on Island Loop, and the county is very pleased with the effort and hard work the Road District has put forth to vastly improve their roads.
